Silent E Syllables Featuring Soft c and g

Typically, the vowel has the long sound in the pattern of vowel-consonant-silent e (*advice*). However, in words that end in an unaccented syllable *-ice* (*service, practice*), the silent e preserves the soft sound of the c, but the vowel sound is short.
