## Silent E Syllables Featuring Soft c and g

Typically, the vowel has the long sound in the pattern of vowel-consonant-silent <i>e (advice)</i> . However, in words that end in an unaccented syllable <i>-ice (service, practice)</i> , the silent <i>e</i> preserves the soft sound of the <i>c</i> , but the vowel sound is short.	Wordsmith Words:
