R Controlled Syllables Featuring Rebel R

There are three primary ways to spell the sound heard in *air*: *air*, *are*, *ear*. This is no rule to follow about which spelling to use but the most frequent spelling is *are*.

The suffix *-aire* is a noun-forming suffix that identifies a person or object occupied by the item named by the root.
