# COVERS

## Vowel Team Syllables Featuring *-oi* and *-oy*

The Slinky Vowel sound /oi/ is spelled *oi*, *oy*. It is considered a Slinky Vowel as it is neither a long vowel sound nor a short vowel sound. The spelling *oi* is used at the beginning and middle of words. The spelling *oy* is used at the end of words.
