Vowel Team Syllables Featuring -oi and -oy

The Slinky Vowel sound /oi/ is spelled oi, oy. It is considered a Slinky Vowel as it is neither a long vowel sound nor a short vowel sound. The spelling oi is used at the beginning and middle of words. The spelling oy is used at the end of words.	Wordsmith Words:
