Vowel Team Syllables Featuring *-ou* and *-ow*

The Slinky Vowel sound /ow/ is spelled *ou*, *ow*. It is considered a Slinky Vowel as it is neither a long vowel sound nor a short vowel sound. The spelling *ou* is used at the beginning and middle of words. The spelling *ow* is used at the end of words and before *l* and *n*.
