

The Walker Vowel Teams *ai* and *ay* follow the old jingle: When two vowels go walking, the first one does the talking. These two spellings both spell  $/\bar{a}/$ . The spelling *ai* is used at the beginning and middle of words. The spelling *ay* is used at the end of words. The spelling *ay* is the Best Spelling for  $/\bar{a}/$  at the end of words and the spelling *ai* is the Best Spelling for  $/\bar{a}/$  before *l* or *n*.
