Closed Syllables featuring Super-Sized Spellings

The Closed Syllable is one of the six syllable types. It consists of one vowel followed by one or more consonants. The vowel sound is short. A closed syllable may have a Super-Sized Spelling. These spellings are used in one-syllable words for certain sounds that come after a short vowel: -ck for /k/, -tch for /ch/, -dge for /j/.
