# COVERS

## Open Syllables featuring an ending y.

This week, the letter y spells /ī/ in words that accent the final syllable: *rely, deny, comply, supply*. Also, when the letter y ends a word in an unaccented syllable, the y spells /ē/: *city, probably, copy, study, tiny, body, entry, quality*.
