Words Featuring Open A Syllables with a schwa sound.

Schwa is a neutral vowel sound. The symbol $\bar{\mathfrak{d}}$ represents this sound. The word ago is pronounced $\bar{\mathfrak{d}}/g\bar{\mathfrak{d}}$. An open a at the end of word always has the schwa; an open a at the beginning often has the schwa, as in the words ago and again.	Wordsmith Words: 1
